

Survey Coverage




- •832 households surveyed in the Lower San Antonio neighborhood


- •93% of residents speak a language other than English at home











- •45% of households made \$20,000 or less in income
- •18% of families with children didn't have enough money for food








83% of households "with children" have an employed adult


- •62% of residents (16- 64 years old) are employed
- •11% of employed adults had more than 1 job












Lower San Antonio: Homicides from 2001-2006







- •38% of residents say that drugs or drunks are very common or common
- •23% of residents feel that gangs are very common or common in the neighborhood








- •Only 11% of residents feel that racial incidents are very common or common






Community Safety - Police

Police are quick to respond when called...

- •38% of residents strongly agree or agree
- •40% strongly disagree or disagree

Police are helpful when dealing with residents...

- •54% of residents strongly agree or agree
- •22% strongly disagree or disagree








Suspicious of neighbors: 52.3% of families with children are highly suspicious of neighbors

Safety Score: 28.8% of families with children gave their neighborhood a high safety score

Graffiti: 70% of residents say that graffiti is rare or not found; 53% would most likely do something about graffiti

Fights: 59% of residents would do something about a fight






- •74% of households have a bank account

- •59% of households have access to credit










Question 6: Do LSA kids have better, same or worse attendance at school than the rest of Oakland?








LSA pre-school aged children vs. licensed childcare supply







Question 7: What % of folks think their neighborhood are willing to help?



Neighborhood Attitudes

- •58% think the neighborhood is safe for children
- •Slight drop between 2004 in 2006 in community optimism
 - 45% of residents participate in local organizations
 - 27% of residents are volunteers/local leaders
